

## Study Material for Bicycle License Test

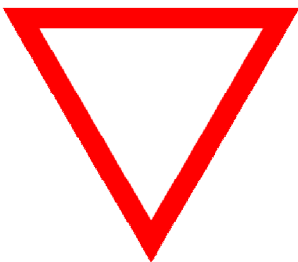
- Red signal means **Stop**
- Green Signal says / indicates **Go**
- Yellow / Amber signal indicates prepare to **Start**
- At the traffic signal the cycle should be stopped **behind the zebra crossing**
- The following sign represents **Keep left**



- The following sign represents **No Entry**



- The following sign represents **give way**



- The following sign represents **No 'U' Turn**



- The following signal indicates **both ways entry prohibited**



- The following sign indicates **no stopping OR standing**



- The following sign **indicates restriction end sign**



- The following sign indicates **right hand curve**



- The following sign indicates **Left hand curve**



- The following sign indicates **School Ahead.**



- This sign indicates **Pedestrian zebra crossing**



The following sign indicates **Hump or rough road**



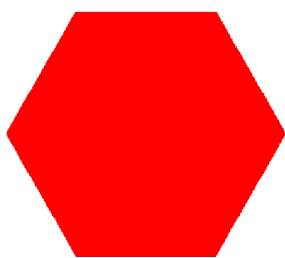
- The following sign Indicates **Cycle Prohibited.**



- You are allowed to park on a footpath and on top of a hill.
- A cyclist is signalling to turn right and drawn to center of the road, you should over take through left side
- Basic rule on a two lane high way is keep to the left lane unless over taking
- The middle lane is for vehicles at 40 km/h
- The following sign represents- **Do not turn right.**



- The following sign represents **STOP**



- The following sign represents **do not blow Horn**



- **Only single and double seat** is allowed on a two wheeler.
- Ambulance and fire service vehicles should be given a free lane.
- You should put a Red or Yellow radium indication behind your vehicle
- Always wear a helmet while ridding bicycle or two wheeler.
- Always use a back brake for stopping or slowing your cycle
- Use of horn is prohibited **Near hospital & court of law**
- Always slow down the speed when you approach a speed breaker
- Maintain a safe distance between a cyclist and Four Wheeler / Three wheeler / Two wheeler
- You can overtake a vehicle in front **through the right side of that vehicle**

- When the slippery road sign is seen on the road the driver shall **reduce the speed.**
- If you are approaching unmanned level railway crossing you have **to stop and check for trains**
- Parking is permitted where the **parking space is allotted.**
- If you get a call while riding your cycle you will **stop at one side and receive the call.**
- You see a pedestrian waiting at a crossing ahead you should **come to a complete stop and wait them to cross**
- While turning to left the driver of two wheeler / cycle should **show left turn signal with his right hand**
- You should always ride to the **left hand side** of the road.
- Zebra crossing are meant for **pedestrian crossing.**
- A state driving license is valid for use all over India.

- You can overtake the vehicle only when the driver of the vehicle in front shows the signal to overtake
- A continuous yellow line down the middle of road means **you are not allowed to overtake.**
- It is permissible to exceed the speed limit **If the road is empty.**
- This signal represents **to stop the vehicle from front**



- This signal represents **to stop the vehicle from behind**



- This signal represents **to stop the vehicle from behind and front**



- This signal represents to **slow down the vehicle.**



- This signal represents **to stop vehicle**



- This signal represents **to turn right**





- This signal represents **to turn left**



- This sign represents **Parking lot – scooter and motorcycles**
- When a blind person crosses the road holding white cane **The driver of a vehicle shall consider the white cane as a traffic sign to stop the vehicle.**



- The sign represents **Steep ascent**



- When the vehicle behind has begun to overtake our vehicle **we should not overtake another vehicle.**
- Rear view mirror is used **for watching the traffic approaching from behind**
